

Minutes for January 4th, 2017 Monthly Meeting

(The regularly scheduled Monthly Meeting was held immediately after the Organizational Meeting was gaveled closed.)

Trustees Derek Myers, Jim Endsley, and Ed Bright, Fiscal Officer Jesenko, and Zoning Inspector Witney were all present.

The minutes for the December End of Year were read and approved.


The Zoning Inspector Report included a lot split request and a possible zoning change request. January 30th, 2017 at 7:30 o'clock was selected as the date and time for the Special Meeting regarding a proposed zoning change.

There was no report from the Southwest Licking Fire District or from the Johnstown Monroe Fire Department, but there was some question as to whether we were invoiced for the fire contract bill. Fiscal Officer will make inquiry.

Communications, letters, telephone calls; Howard Fry made inquiry as to how many animals are allowed on a piece of ground in Jersey Township as his grandson would like to run some hogs. Trustee Endsley directed him to the Zoning Inspector. The Board directed the Zoning Inspector to consult with the County Prosecutor for adjudication.

Old Business; attendance confirmed for the Board and the Fiscal Officer to go to the Licking County Township Association Meeting. Additionally, Trustee Endsley attended the Blacklick Creek Watershed Meeting directed to government entities. They are concentrating on water quality southwest of Jersey Township. They are concerned about runoff from area farms, but measures they endorse would not be hospitable to how land is farmed at present.

New business; Trustee Endsley suggested we should look at updating our Comprehensive Plan in light of the Mink Road Interchange, specifically the land use map. Updating the Plan was preferred over rewriting it. Several cemetery deeds were signed. The next Monthly Meeting was announced to be on Monday February 6th 2017, and with no public comment, the meeting was adjourned.
