NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids for the 2025 Paving & Culvert Replacement project will be received by the Jersey Township Trustees, 1481 Mink St. SW, Pataskala, Ohio 43062 until Monday, May 5, 2025, at 7:00 PM local time, and then and there publicly opened and read aloud.

The 2025 Paving & Culvert Replacement project includes a box culvert replacement on Caswell Road and Burnside Road. The project also includes the resurfacing of approximately 12000' of roadway along Burnside Road, Caswell Road, and Green Chapel Road.

Complete sets of bidding documents may only be purchased through Verdantas LLC. Bidders may obtain electronic bidding documents upon payment of \$25.00 (non-refundable) in the form of cash or check payable to Verdantas LLC. Bidding documents may also be obtained as hardcopy upon receipt of \$100.00 plus \$20.00 shipping fees at the above office.

Bidders are required to provide Bid security in the form of a Bid Bond in the amount of 100 percent of the Bid Price or certified check, cashier's check or letter of credit equal to ten percent of the bid amount to guarantee the Bidder's entrance into a contract, if awarded the project. Each bid must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the bid and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity, and a complete listing of all subcontractors to be used. Submit your offer on the Bid Form provided within these Bid Documents.

Each Bidder must ensure that all employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, handicap, ancestry, or age. All contractors and subcontractors involved with the project shall to the extent practicable use Ohio products, materials, services and labor in the implementation of their project. Additionally, contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123 is required.

Bidders must comply with the prevailing wage rates on Public Improvements in Licking County as determined by the State of Ohio Wage Determinations.

The Engineer's estimate is as follows: **\$1,085,800.00**

Your offer will be required to be submitted under a condition of irrevocability for a period of 60 days after submission. In the event that the Owner is unable to obtain an Agreement with the Bidder initially selected, the Owner may award the contract to the next bid, most favorable to the Owner. The right is reserved by the Owner to reject any or all bids, and to waive any informality in bids received and to accept any bid which is deemed to be the lowest and best bid.
